1. Qualification (max 20 points)

1.1 Master Degree Final Mark – (max 6 points)

Or for students attaining the MD within October 31

1.1. Score Degree Of The Exams

1.2 Scientific Publications (max 8 points)

1.3 Research Experience (max 6 points)

2. Research Project (max 30 points)

Knowledge of the topics (max 5 points)

Originality (max 5 points)

Clarity and thoroughness (max 5 points)

Feasibility of the project (max 5 points)

Consistency with the PhD objectives (max 10 points)

The evaluation committee will assign a score ranging from 0 to 50.

N.B. Only applicants obtaining a minimum score of 30/50 will take part in the on-site interview.

3. On-site Interview (max 70 points)

The scores of the Research Project (max 45 points)

Clarity of the presentation and knowledge of the topics (max 25 points)

On-site interview will be held in English and will include applicant's presentation of his/her research proposal, discussion and personal motivations for applying to the Ph.D in Psychology and Social Neuroscience.

N.B. The evaluation committee will assign a score ranging from 0 to 70. **Only applicants obtaining a minimum score of 50/70 will pass the competition.**
